## Monthly Meetings and Fun Fly Challenges

Remember, the first of every month is our meeting; and, these meetings will be held at the field pending a major rain-storm or if we see Pecos Bill riding in on a tornado.

### ***Why should you attend?***

Well, because there's going to be some really fun RC flying challenges to meet all skill levels with rewards at the end of the year..

### ***Will it Be Fair?***

To make the competition fair; new flyers will be given handicap points toward achieving the same results as a more experienced flyer. Meaning that Dan Powell, Rhett, Nick and some others can't take all the gold. But they will try...

### ***So, what's in it for you?***

Each challenge in the fun fly (like Touch and Go's; shortest time to takeoff, do 3 loops and land etc.) will result in points accumulated throughout the year and at the end of the year, the winners in the respective classes (to-be-determined) will be awarded as follows.

- First will get 100% of their 2025 dues payed;
- Second will get 50% of their dues covered;
- Third will get 25% of their dues covered.

Along the way toward the end of the year, we hope to have a number of event prizes and awards to hand out as well. [*Donations Appreciated*]

### ***What's the Cost?***

Now, you might ask what's the cost to do this? Well, only \$5 per fun fly is all that you need to cough up to join in the fun.

### ***When?***

**The first event (trial basis) is coming up really soon after the Saturday, March 2nd meeting. Don't miss this; your input is needed going forward.**

**So, don't forget, come to a meeting (first Saturday of the Month) and get in on the fun fly challenges immediately following.**

### **Texoma RC AMA Sanctioned Events**

Throughout 2024 the Texoma RC club hopes to sanction several major events to include members from other clubs - to come and join in the challenges and get any Fun Fly get-togethers. So far, the calendar looks like this:

- **Apr 27 - Tail Twister (Heli) Event**
- **May 18/19 - Scale Fly-In & Scale Masters Qualifying Competition**
- **Sep 28 - IMAC (Scale) Aerobatics**
- **Oct 5 - Pete Darter Fly In & Swap Meet**

Note, that this year in the IMAC Scale Aerobatic competitions, one added almost guaranteed component will be Freestyle Competition.

Competitors will accumulate freestyle points at each event toward the South Central Regional IMAC Finals in Odessa Texas. To make it worthwhile, Extreme Flight has partnered with the IMAC organization and all the regions where the top dog in freestyle will receive a new giant scale plane for all their efforts. And, to fly Freestyle, all you need to do is fly at least the Basic sequence at each event.

So, get your musical creativity going and compile a 4 min routine that fits your style of flying - its sure to be one 10-step aerial dancing good time! I can think of a couple good songs that would really fit... Crazy (Patsy Cline); Thunder Rolls (Garth Brooks); All My Exe's (George Straight); and let's not forget Oh Boy! (Buddy Holly). Of course, there's always Metallica, Rush (Doug Pilcher's favorite), Black Sabbath as well. Bring it on and let's rock the skies!

Can you think of an event we should host; RC Combat, Glider Duration, Pylon Racing - bring it up at the monthly club meeting and let's make some of these happen.
