NATS IMAC Challenges

In Muncie July 15-July 19, Danny Powell and Conrad Nerdahl went to the NATS to compete in the National Scale Aerobatic (IMAC) Competition. The event was challenging with lots of obstacles offered by nature; Wind, Rain, Low Cloud Cover, Fog etc. This in addition to plane issues; engine performance, covering, tail wheels, and such. In short, it was a wakeup call and a learning experience to see what's involved in getting to Muncie as well as competing successfully. The journey itself and everything about it was fun.

What was immediately learned was an understanding of the scoring criteria relative to flying criteria in how to succeed, or in some cases, not to succeed. While optimistic aspirations of success were present in attending and doing well, it wasn't till the last day where everything started clicking. Sadly, by then it

was too late to climb back up the ladder to the medal round category. But the learning was fantastic, the comradery and help was incredible and great constructive advice in how to move forward. From there, the fire was lit on how to go back in 2025 and apply all the lessons learned.

If you missed it, the only recommendation is that something like this needs to be attended at least once. For Conrad this was a bucket list item but kindled a competitive spirit to take what was learned and go back and try again in 2025. In fact, the challenge is to have as many South-Central IMAC members attend as possible in 2025 - to show SW and SE that SC does have IMAC flyers. Also, 2025 will no doubt be a qualifying run for the IMAC Worlds Competition tentatively slated for Argentina in 2026. It'd be great to see a few folks from SC (Texas) IMAC qualify... hint-hint!




