A Message from Our Club President - David Taylor

March has been a great month. Not only did we have several days of great weather for flying, but we also completed several projects at the field.

The electrical for the RV parking spots is completed except for a final test which will happen shortly. There are a few modifications to the existing electrical that needs to be done but they are not pressing for overall field use.

Thank you to all who helped with the field workday on March 8. Some needed weed eating and painting was completed. There is still some work to be done along the west fence to complete the weed eating there.

The county has cleared the trees from the fence row of the adjacent property to the north. Please remember that the power poles and lines are still there.

New starting stations were installed last week. Each pad is concrete with multiple holes to adjust the hold-back poles as needed depending on the size of your airplane. They will be ready for use by April 1. The installation of the pads was made possible through the donations of several club members. Please tell Darryl Ellison thank you for calling Hope Concrete to inquire about them donating the concrete for the pads.

Event season has arrived and the calendar is getting full for the next two months. Our first event will be the scale fly-in on May 17 and 18, followed by the

Float Fly-in on May 31. Dan has scheduled the annual IMAC Event for September 20 and 21.

Scale Flying

I would like to encourage everyone that has a scale plane to participate in the scale fly-in. The event will have categories all levels of flight ability and for virtually any airplane as long as it is a scale model of a real airplane. All airplanes will be judged in a series of flights. There will be three to four rounds of flights with each round consisting of 2 flights. We will complete two or three on Saturday and add one more on Sunday morning. The only scale documentation needed is a picture of the real airplane for the pro/am sportsman and pro/am pro categories. The advanced and expert will require complete documentation per AMA rules and will participate in static judging.

Each flight will consist of ten maneuvers that the real airplane modeled is capable of. For instance, a Pitts Special can perform a snap roll since the full size Pitts is an aerobatic airplane. A P-51 would get zero points for performing a snap roll as the full size P-51 cannot snap roll. Basic maneuvers that must be completed in each flight include take-off, low pass between 10 and 20 feet high above the runway, horizontal figure eight, landing, and overall scale appearance of the flight. The maneuvers can be flown in any sequence after take-off and before landing.

Float Flying

Put simply, flying off the water is fun. Floats can be made or purchased for most any airplane that flies. Many of the newer ARF's have float options ready made. If you need floats, let me know as I have an article written by Chuck Cunningham on how to make your own floats. Takes about a weekend to make a simple set. While any plane can be placed on floats, some are far better than others. High wing planes like Cubs make excellent first float planes. We have two months until our float fly-in so get your planes ready now.

IMAC Flying

We will get Dan or someone to provide a summary of scale aerobatic flying in one of the next newsletters.

Lastly, it has been decided to postpone the crawfish/shrimp boil due to the forecasted weather on Saturday. With the cost of crawfish and the fact that it has to be fresh we are not going to gamble on having the forecasted storms put a stop to the boil. Also, if it is stormy on Saturday we will move the meeting to Grandy's in Sherman, but only if it is storming. The monthly fun fly will follow the meeting.

5) Startup Box Summary of work and photos.

Over the past 2-3 weeks, two cement startup stands for larger aircraft were constructed; one on each side of the runway tarmac. The significance of these stands is they were designed and built so that holding wing poles could be adjusted for the width of varying aircraft so that they could be used with a variety of aircraft and aircraft types. The startup stands can be used as early as tomorrow afternoon.

Finally the truck arrives with the cement




Here's a crew working one of the two frames


