

5) Startup Box Summary of work and photos.

The Club completed the construction of two cement startup stands for larger aircraft; one on each side of the runway tarmac. The significance of these stands is they were designed and built so that holding wing poles could be adjusted for the width of varying aircraft so that they could be used with a variety of aircraft and aircraft types. The startup stands can be used as early as tomorrow afternoon. The North stand is operational; the South stand needs foam noodles over the wing poles and some minor groundwork - raking and smoothing done.

Finally the truck arrives with the cement




Here's a crew working one of the two frames



The Flying field is located at 734 Logston Road, Sherman, TX (Google app)


