Several people went out to the field afterwards to watch the IMAC event as it was the same weekend. Overall a great day other than being a little on the warm side. ## 2) IMAC Event Summary - 29th Annual Texoma IMAC

Overall, there were 16 pilots flying in the 29th Annual Texoma IMAC contest. In no particular order they were: Blake Fougerousse, Brad Ahlfinger, Brandon Kent, Brian Strachan, Conrad Nerdahl, Daniel Powell, Ken Rogers, Mark Thurman, Nick Scharping, Phil Waul, Rhett Lambert, Ryan Clark, Timothy Hughes, Travis Taylor, Wes Crider and Wesley Pennington. These pilots flew a grand total of 226 judged sequences.

Brandon Kent won the **Basic class**. There were 2 pilots in Basic. The winning order was: (1) Brandon Kent and (2) Wes Crider.

Ryan Clark won the **Sportsman class**. There were 4 pilots in Sportsman. The winning order was: (1) Ryan Clark, (2) Blake Fougerousse, (3) Brad Ahlfinger and (4) Wesley Pennington.

Travis Taylor won the **Intermediate class**. There were 4 pilots in Intermediate. The winning order was: (1) Travis Taylor, (2) Ken Rogers, (3) Phil Waul and (4) Conrad Nerdahl. *[Editors Note - Phil may have likely edged Ken out of 2nd had it not been for his caller - yours truly (this editor) for leading Phil into an incorrect entry for a maneuver which resulted in a cascading domino effect - the challenge, was Ken was flying exceptionally well. It was a battle for 2nd as the scores going into the Unknown between Ken and Phil were extremely close with Phill having a slight edge prior to things going south.]*

Brian Strachan won the **Advanced class**. There were 2 pilots in Advanced. The winning order was: (1) Brian Strachan and (2) Timothy Hughes.

Nick Scharping won the **Unlimited class**. There were 4 pilots in Unlimited. The winning order was: (1) Nick Scharping, (2) Rhett Lambert, (3) Daniel Powell and (4) Mark Thurman.

Blake Fougerousse won the Seniors class. There were 7 pilots in Seniors. The winning order was: (1) Blake Fougerousse, (2) Brad Ahlfinger, (3) Ken Rogers, (4) Phil Waul, (5) Timothy Hughes, (6) Conrad Nerdahl and (7) Mark Thurman.

Ryan Clark won the King of Unknowns class. There were 14 pilots in King of Unknowns. The winning order was: (1) Ryan Clark, (2) Wesley Pennington, (3) Blake Fougerousse, (4) Nick Sharping, (5) Travis Taylor, (6) Rhett Lambert, (7) Brad Ahlfinger, (8) Brian Strachan, (9) Timothy Hughes, (10) Daniel Powell, (11) Ken Rogers, (12) Conrad Nerdahl, (13) Phil Waul, and (14) Mark Thurman.

Daniel Powell won the Freestyle class. There were 2 pilots in Freestyle. The winning order was: (1) Daniel Powell and (2) Wesley Pennington.

The tightest competition was for 1st place in the Sportsman class, with only 27.2 points difference between Ryan Clark and Blake Fougousse.



The Flying field is located at 734 Logston Road, Sherman, TX (Google app)


